

GEOPHYSICS OPEN-ACCESS LICENSE AGREEMENT

For and in consideration of the potential publication of the article listed above (the “Work”) by the Society of Exploration Geophysicists (“SEG”), I, the undersigned, as lead and/or corresponding author and/or rights-holder and acting on behalf of all authors and/or owners of copyright in the Work (“Authors”), elect to exercise the option of publishing the Work on an open-access basis under one of the four Creative Commons licenses supported by SEG publications as selected herein and hereby grant SEG permission to publish the Work, effective if and when the article is accepted by SEG for publication, subject to limitations expressed in this Open-Access License Agreement (“Agreement”). “Authors” refers to each and all authors and all rights-holders in the Work and all such persons and entities jointly and severally; they share all rights and responsibilities equally, and if any Author is unable to share in a responsibility, the others become responsible for that Author’s share. The signing person(s) represents and warrants that she or he (they) have full power to enter into this Agreement on behalf of Authors and to make the grants contained herein.

The “Work” means all material to be published as part of the article, in any medium, including but not limited to tables, figures, graphs, source code, movies, and other multimedia. Responses to discussions of the Work, errata, and other similar material directly related to the Work that may arise subsequent to article publication also are considered part of the Work.

Authors warrant that this Work has not been published previously in any form except as a preprint unless explicitly noted, nor is it under consideration by any other publisher, and that the Work does not infringe any copyright, trademark, or trade secret or otherwise invade any right of privacy or publicity or violate any statutory or common-law right. Authors agree to indemnify, defend, and hold SEG, its directors, officers, employees, and agents harmless against any claims to the contrary.

Authors warrant that they have complied and will comply with Ethical Guidelines for SEG Publications and that they agree to the provisions of these guidelines.

Authors retain copyright and, with a check next to the applicable paragraph, select the Creative Commons license under which the Work is hereby licensed to the public and to SEG. (If no box is checked, the Creative Commons Attribution 4.0 license will be regarded as the default selection.)

- Creative Commons Attribution 4.0 license (CC BY): This license lets others distribute, remix, tweak, and build upon the Work, even commercially, as long as they credit the author and/or licensors for the original creation. This license meets licensing requirements of the Research Councils UK.
- Creative Commons Attribution-NonCommercial 4.0 license (CC BY-NC): This license allows the same uses and has the same attribution requirement as CC BY but excludes commercial use of the paper.
- Creative Commons Attribution-ShareAlike 4.0 license (CC BY-SA): This license allows the same uses and has the same attribution requirement as CC BY except that all derivative works must carry the same license, so any derivatives also will allow commercial use. The SEG Wiki and Wikipedia use this license.

Creative Commons Attribution-NonCommercial-NoDerivatives 4.0 license (CC BY-NC-ND): This is the most restrictive of the Creative Commons licenses, allowing others to download and share the author's work with attribution but without the right to create derivatives or to use the work commercially.

Authors acknowledge that this Agreement is contingent upon their completion and submission of an SEG Publications Fees Election Form indicating agreement to pay the open-access fee and all other applicable publication fees.

Authors enjoy the right to prepare and hold copyright in derivative publications based on the Work provided that the derivative work is published subsequent to the official date of the original article's publication by SEG.

Authors enjoy the right to post to their own Web sites a preprint (a version prior to the GEOPHYSICS accepted and published version) of the Work provided that the posting is accompanied by prominent notice that the Work is under review for publication in GEOPHYSICS.

In addition to rights extended to licensees under the Creative Commons license selected, Authors extend rights to SEG, as follows:

- 1) Authors extend to SEG worldwide license to publish the article, all associated supplemental material, and subsequent, if necessary, errata in any SEG publication under the terms of the Creative Commons license selected by Authors. Authors agree that subsequent Discussions and Replies associated with the article be licensed and published under the same Creative Commons license as the paper itself.
- 2) Authors agree to acknowledge the SEG-published version of the Work as the version of record. Authors agree that further distribution of the Work must maintain attribution to the author(s), the article title, journal citation, and DOI (linked to the SEG official version if in electronic form). SEG states this requirement in the article alongside indication of the Creative Commons license under which Authors have licensed the Work.
- 3) Authors grant to SEG the right to enforce rights in the work, on behalf of Authors and SEG, against third parties in cases of infringement, plagiarism, ethical disputes, and fraud. Authors also grant SEG nonexclusive right to extend to third parties content-reuse permissions that exceed the rights granted to third parties under the Creative Commons license selected by Authors.

This Agreement shall be binding on Authors' heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, and shall be construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Oklahoma, United States of America.
